



US TSCA Letter of Compliance

On [February 20th, 2024](#) the EPA published an updated TSCA chemical substance inventory. The Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA) authorizes the EPA to regulate and screen all chemicals produced or imported into the United States to prevent unreasonable risks to health and the environment. The TSCA bans toxic substances including substances containing five PBTs, Phenol, isopropylated phosphate 3:1 (PIP 3:1), Pentachlorothiophenol (PCPT), Decabromodiphenyl Ether (DecaBDE), Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD), and 2,4,6-TTBP (tris(tert-butyl)phenol)).

Based on the information received from our suppliers and the best of our knowledge, our products do not intentionally contain any of the aforementioned chemicals.
